**APPLICATION FOR FULL- OR HALF-TIME EQUIVALENCY**

Please refer to Section 7 of the GSAS Policies and Procedures (available as a PDF from <http://www.nyu.edu/gsas/OASL/index.html>) for a full description of the full- and half-time equivalency procedures. Briefly, :

- **Full-Time Equivalency**—A student may claim full-time status based on any combination of academic research, work as a Graduate or Research assistant, internships, and coursework requiring at least 40 hours per week (the equivalent of 12 credits).
- **Half-time Equivalency**—A student may claim half-time status based on any combination of academic research, work as a Graduate or Research assistant, internships, and coursework requiring at least at least 20 hours per week (the equivalent of 6 credits).
- Students on approved Leaves of Absence are not entitled to either full- or half-time equivalency.
- Students pursuing the Draper Master's degree may have up to four semesters of full-time status.
